


### GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE EPS

The European Project Semester is a 4-month program in English for Bachelor students in Engineering, Computer Sciences, and Business Management/Administration. The semester is a mixture of project work and courses, and the students collaborate in international and interdisciplinary teams. The courses include teambuilding, communication, project management, presentation skills and languages. The students' projects are initiated and completed in cooperation with local companies. Many of the students find it valuable to be an integral part of a real-world, hands-on project. EPS is offered by 17 providers in 12 different European countries.




### **PROJECTS**

Teams of students from different national, academic and professional backgrounds carry out EPS projects. The members are allocated to the different teams according to home study, project interests, nationality, personality and occupational analysis.

A close cooperation between Kiel UAS and companies from the region enables the students to work on a real project. Topics of the projects in Kiel mainly focus on issues of engineering, business and IT disciplines. Students from different academic and cultural backgrounds work together in teams to carry out real-world industrial projects in the fields of electrical and mechanical engineering, IT, shipbuilding and business administration. Local enterprises assign the actual project tasks. Working in international teams of 4-5 people, the students learn to cooperate and to communicate with each other at a professional, expert level. Moreover, they get to hone their presentation and negotiation skills. Each team is provided with a student from Kiel, an academic lecturer and a business coach.


